Change the following sentences to the future perfect tense. Use expressions like 'even', 'more' or 'even more' as shown in the example.

Example: the situation of women has changed greatly.

By 2010, the situation of women will have changed even more.

- a. *Developing rural areas has become a necessity. (By 2010, developing rural areas will have become a necessity).*
- b. *Some men have begun to help women in the housework. (by the end of this decade, more men will have begun even more help women .*
- c. *some women have become aware of their roles in society (More women will have more become aware of their roles in society by 2010).*
- d. *Some youths have started to take part in political life. (By 2017, more youths will have taken part even more in political life).*
- e. *Tanks to women's education, families have become smaller, (In a short time from now, families will have become more smaller .*
- f. *thanks to the initiative for Developing Human Resources, the government has launched some interesting Workshops. (By 2010, the government will have launched even more interesting workshops).*
